

GOOD SHEPHERD CHRISITIAN ACADEMY DRESS CODE POLICY

TOPS:(Plain Blue, black, khaki, white)

- Knit or fleece sweaters
- Good Shepherd Christian Academy Shirt Polos or any color collared polo shirt

BOTTOMS:(Plain *blue*, *black* or *khaki*)

- All skirts, skorts, jumpers and shorts must be mid-thigh length.
- Regular full length size pants school color appropriate
- Pants must be fitted and worn at the waist with a belt if necessary.
- Girls flat front uniform straight fit pants are recommended
- Shorts are recommended to be worn, weather permitting May 20 thru Oct. 1

SHOES:

- Gym shoes or dress shoes / An extra pair of gym shoes are to be kept at school
- Shoes that could be damaging to furniture or floors cannot be worn.
- Boots should be worn during inclement weather and removed immediately upon entering the building. An extra pair of shoes must be available to put on after the removal of boots.

HAIR/NAIL:

- Hair must be a single natural color (black, brown, blonde, natural red etc.)
- Natural Nail or clear polish only
- Students are required to dress and groom in a manner that is neat & clean

UNACCEPTABLE:

- Skinny uniform type pants are unacceptable for girls and boys.
- No, fake artificial nails or colored nail polish
- Shoes that could be damaging to furniture or floors cannot be worn.
- All school clothing must be clean, in good condition and fit properly. Holes, distressed areas, tears or faded fabric are not permitted.
- For tops:(NO PICTURES, WORDS or HOODIES)
- For hair: (NO COLORED HAIR, EXAMPLE BLUE, ORANGE, GREEN, PURPLE, ETC).

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS:

(When a student is found to be in violation of the school dress code)

- 1. The teacher and / or principal will privately discuss the violation with the student.
- 2. Corrective action will be taken such as:

- 4. The student will be sent to the office to call home for a change of clothes.

- entanglement. No jewelry may be worn during gym class or athletic events. School time will not be used to look for missing jewelry items.
- The school will not be responsible for harm resulting from jewelry
- MISCELLANEOUS -No visible tattoos (permanent or temporary) are allowed.
